SPIRITUAL PREPAREDNESS

Healing to the Nations is the number 1 mandate given to our man of God. We must reach every nation, tribe, and tongue with this mandate.

Translations is a God-given opportunity to be His outstretched arm for the healing of others. You are His voice to all who can hear your language.

As a translator;

- You have been sent to preach the Gospel to all who can hear your language (Romans 10:14).

When people are cut off from their language, they are cut off from understanding, which is what brings the vital benefits of the Word.
- You draw men to the Lord when you speak Kingdom realities in their language. People identify with their language (Acts 2).

PRAY.

- Pray at intervals daily concerning your work as you minister with our dear man of God, and for its impact on people all over the world.

BE FILLED WITH THE SPIRIT.

- Speak in tongues and meditate on the Word.
- Maintain focus and consciousness that you are not just transmitting sound, you're transmitting spirit and life.
- Be sensitive to the spirit at all times, as you are a healing minister.



TECHNICAL SET UP: Checklist For Translators

Live translation will be on beta.hslive.org

- ✓ **Device and accessories**
 - Either a laptop or an android device.
 - Earphones or headset with microphone
 - Chargers, power banks, UPS, etc.
 - Device should have at least 4GB RAM and 10GB free memory space. Set mobile device to DO NOT DISTURB while translating.

- ✓ **Steady Internet Access**
 - For stable internet connection for streaming, consider using a wired Ethernet connection instead of Wi-Fi if possible
 - Recommended speed: **5mbps minimum**
 - Check your internet speed at fast.com

- ✓ **A Quiet Environment**
 - Work in a secluded space for better focus and fewer distractions.

- ✓ **Steady Power Supply**
 - If you are streaming from a location prone to frequent power outages, please arrange for a backup or inverter



TECHNICAL SET UP: Device Specifications

FOR LAPTOPS

To set up using your laptop, kindly ensure that your laptop has the following:

- Windows 10/11 or macOS operating system
- At least 8GB ram is recommended
- Chrome Brower (please do not use safari or Firefox)
- Good battery life

FOR MOBILE DEVICES

Android smartphones and tablet with these features are recommended:

- Android 11 OS or later
- Microphone
- Loudspeaker
- Bluetooth or 3.5mm jack for (headphones connectivity)
- At least 4GB Ram
- Wi-Fi



TECHNICAL SET UP: Using Your Microphone

Use a microphone-enabled headset or earpiece enhances the audio quality of your live translation. This will;

- Reduce background noise,
- Provide a more professional and immersive experience for your audience.

It's an essential tool for clear communication and contributes to an overall positive streaming experience.

Kindly ensure you have connected your headset/earpiece before logging into your account on the Translators Portal as this will help the browser detect your audio input before the your stream goes live.



TECHNICAL SET UP: Internet Access

To ensure a stable internet connection for streaming, consider using a wired Ethernet connection instead of Wi-Fi, if possible.

- **Your internet upload and download speed should be at least 5Mbps or more for a seamless experience.**
- **To check the above, visit fast.com.**
- **Regularly test your internet speed and troubleshoot any issues promptly to maintain a reliable connection during the services.**



TECHNICAL SET UP: Your Environment

A nice, quiet streaming environment is crucial when translating live. To achieve this, kindly consider the following tips:

- **Choose a dedicated space with minimal ambient noise.**
- **Close windows and doors to reduce external sounds.**
- **Use noise-cancelling technologies in headphones or microphones.**
- **Inform people in your living space about your streaming schedule to minimize disruptions and distractions.**



TECHNICAL SET UP: Steps For Live Translations

- ✓ Kindly go to beta.hslive.org
- ✓ Login with your email address and password. Opt to register if you don't have these details.
- ✓ For first time translators, wait for the server to launch. Might take up to 2 minutes.
- ✓ Once ready, page will refresh and a "PUBLISH" button will appear. Push this and commence your translation.
- ✓ On the Healing Streams website, people will now see your language and can listen to you.
- ✓ Contact us via the KC group or liaison managers for further information or assistance.



KEY NOTES FOR EVERY TRANSLATOR

YOUR WELFARE

Every healing service starts @ 3 PM (GMT+1) and will last for 5 to 7 hours. To ensure that you deliver optimally throughout, please note and apply the following welfare tips.

- ✓ Sleep early, so you are well rested and active before each day's program**
- ✓ Eat well; have a meal one hour to the program.**
- ✓ Drink water; Have a bottle of water with you for hydration and to lubricate your vocal cords.**
- ✓ Dress comfortably; consider wearing t-shirts, and wear flat sandals to keep light and flexible.**
- ✓ Stay in a comfortable area, so you can stand and stretch your muscles at intervals.**
- ✓ Take 1-3 minute breaks, to stand and stretch.**
